You may have seen this report as part of Vice-President Biden's report but just in case -- the Departments of Labor, Education, Commerce and Health and Human Services produced a 27-page synthesis of evidence regarding what works in education and job training programs.

There is a section on "What Works with Adults" and a section on "What Works with Youth"—and since the proportion of youth funds for out-of-school youth has risen from 30% to 70%, there may be many opportunities for expanding your services to that population.
