U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Releases a Notice of Funding Availability.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development announced the availability of funding of approximately \$24 million for the Jobs Plus Pilot program for Public Housing Agencies to develop locally-based approaches to increase earnings and advance employment outcomes for Public Housing residents. The Notice of Funding Availability will fund initiatives to improve employment and earnings outcomes for Public Housing residents through supports such as work readiness, employer linkages, job placement and financial literacy. Of the \$24 million available, \$9 million is made available from the ROSS appropriations to support the services element of the Jobs Plus Pilot program. To receive 1 point for this objective, applicants must provide evidence of a curriculum and services plan designed to increase beneficiaries' job-readiness, and link participants with employers. Renewal or returning applicants must provide evidence of positive program outcomes, e.g., participants who got a job or improved their employment status (increased income or benefits)
