The State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) is seeking a policy associate in basic education for adults. This full-time, exempt position is based in Olympia, Washington and will serve as a member of the leadership team providing statewide coordination and technical assistance for correctional education programs including basic skills, vocational training, offender change, I-BEST, and other agreed upon education programs offered by eight community colleges in partnership with the Department of Corrections at the state's twelve adult correctional facilities. This position serves as the liaison between Department of Corrections stakeholders, community college partners, and the State Board for Community and Technical College staff.
