U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) invites you to participate in a teleconference on **Thursday, Feb. 12, from 3 to 3:30 p.m. (Eastern)** to discuss the expansion of DACA, one of President Obama's recently announced [executive actions](#) on immigration.

Anyone who came to the United States before their sixteenth birthday and who has been present in the U.S. since Jan. 1, 2010 may request expanded DACA. Expanded DACA will go into effect on Feb. 18, 2015.

To help people prepare, USCIS published [frequently asked questions](#) on expanded DACA and revised [instructions](#) for [Form I-821D, Consideration of Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals](#). During the session, USCIS officials will provide an overview of the frequently asked questions and seek your feedback.
