Grant Opportunity—Citizenship and Naturalization Application Services

You may want to forward this grant notice from the US Citizenship and Immigration Service (USCIS) to your local programs with experience in providing ESL and citizenship. Deadline is May 15, 2015

USCIS just published a new funding opportunity that may be of interest to some of your stakeholders. The grant is for up to \$250,000 over a two year performance period, and requires both the provision of citizenship instruction and naturalization application services to lawful permanent residents. Eligible organizations include non-profit or public organizations that have experience providing ESL and citizenship instruction to adults.
