Regional WIOA Proposed Regulations Review and Response Meetings

To assist you in arranging your travel to the regional meetings, below are tentative WIOA Regional Meeting logistics and procedures.

Agenda: The purposes for these meetings are twofold:

- 1) review the proposed WIOA regulations to familiarize you with critical proposed changes and how they will impact your state;
 - State plans, infrastructure and “other” costs, WIB memberships, EL/Civics and IET, joint data management systems, out-of-school youth and others.
- 2) engage you in formulating responses to the Departments of Education and Labor to ensure final regulations positively impact your state.

Locations and Dates: There are two locations; chose one.

- East Regional-Atlanta
 - Noon May 26 to Noon May 27, 2015
 - Crown Plaza at the Atlanta Airport—free airport shuttle--\$105/night
- West Regional-Denver
 - Noon May 28 to Noon May 29, 2015
 - Hilton Garden at the Denver Airport—free airport shuttle--\$119/night

Hotel and Registration:

- NAEPDC will reimburse hotel expenses for **one person from each member state**
- **Additional attendees** from the member states will pay their own hotel expenses
- **All on-site meals and breaks are provided free to member state participants**
- Registration is free to member states.
- All attendees are responsible for their own transportation costs. NAEPDC cannot pay for transportation costs. (i.e. airlines, airport parking, meals en route, etc.)
- Non-Members of NAEPDC have a registration fee of \$500.

How to Register:

- Once the last couple of planning issues are finalized (in a day or two hopefully) we will set up and send you an online link to register for the regional meeting.
- **DO NOT call the hotel yet**—they will not be ready until we get the hotel contracts

finalized—in a day or two. We have blocked rooms but they need to get set up on their end. We will notify you when this information is available.

We are sure you understand the constraint we are under with the Departments quick turnaround time for responses to the regulations. However, your response to those proposed regulations are of utmost importance. The final regulations will impact your program for years to come.

We hope this is enough information for you to begin the travel approval process. We will provide you with additional information as soon as it is available.
