### Partnership Opportunity—Dislocated Worker Grants

DOL just announced Sector Partnership National Emergency Grants for Dislocated Workers. Below is the url for the announcement.

“Enhanced Career Services” on page 8 includes English Language Acquisition.

“Training and Work-Based Training Models” on page 9 includes “workers with barriers to employment” which includes English language learners and individuals with low levels of literacy.

A number of workers who entered the workforce in the “lift and put” manual labor era do not have the reading, math and English skills needed today. Once dislocated, they have substantial barriers to the current job market.

As a result, you may have opportunity to partner with Title I programs to meet the needs of these dislocated workers.
