The Washington State Board for Community and Technical Colleges (SBCTC) is seeking a Basic Education for Adults (BEa) Policy Associate to join the SBCTC team. Based in Olympia, Washington, this full-time, exempt position is responsible for diversity, equity and inclusion in BEa and serves as a member of the policy leadership team to foster student success; especially for low-income students, students of color, and working adults. The policy associate provides statewide coordination, legislative and technical assistance for providers of BEa programs statewide.

This position functions as a collaborative member of the Basic Education for Adults (BEa) team to promote development and implementation of a statewide program and professional development system to integrate the policies of the Washington State Adult Education 5-year Plan: Pathways to College and Careers for Washington's Emerging Workforce, and the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

The annual salary for this position is \$83,900.16. Washington State has a generous benefit package including health, dental, life insurance, long-term disability, retirement, and two optional deferred compensation programs.
